## CERTIFICATES TO THE WINNERS

Lead bullets only. Limited to <1400 FPS. Shooting at steel targets. Ten shots at each yardage. Iron sights only. Two "sighting" shots are allowed at the longer distances.

Pistol caliber rifle: 50 yards off-hand and 100 yards off cross-sticks. Pistols are 50 yards only off-hand.

Big Bore and BAM: 100 yards off-hand and 200 yards off cross-sticks.

Bolt Action Military (BAM) rifles are a separate smokeless category, same distances as big bore. BAM is an unmodified bolt action rifle issued by any nation's military up until 1940 (no sniper rifles). Ammo must be unjacketed lead projectile, may have gas check. Sights are iron only used by the military of origin. Examples: Lee-Enfield, 1903 Springfield, Schmidt-Rubin, Mauser, Arisaka, Carcano, Mosin-Nagant ...

Tie breaker: five shots at a bottle target at the longer distances.
